

TAKING THE HiSET TEST IN HAMILTON (FORMERLY GED)

You **MUST PREREGISTER** to take the HiSET Test. Go to <http://hiset.ets.org/> to register.

YOU MUST REGISTER ONLINE: Deadline is Midnight on the Wednesday before the Friday test date
****If you are 16, 17, or 18, you will need an override to schedule your testing. You need to set up a profile at the HiSET website and get your ETS ID# before you can request an override. We send your name, date of birth, and ETS ID# to Helena when we request an override so you can schedule your tests.****

You must provide your **social security number** (even though it is not a required field) when registering online. You **must pay** for the online testing fees **with a credit or debit card** or pay-pal account.

If you need to **take all five tests**, you should choose the option to **pay for the battery for \$50**. You can take each test up to three times in one year without paying again online, but you must pay \$5/test at the test center.

If you need to take only one test, you pay \$10 online and \$5 at the test center.

Don't forget to print your registration confirmation **and write down your username and password**.

When is the HiSET Test given?

The HiSET Test is generally given in Hamilton the first Friday of each month. Available dates will show in the HiSET website when you schedule your testing.

Where is the HiSET Test given?

Bitterroot College, Room 118, at 103 South 9th ST, Hamilton, MT. This may be subject to change. The current site will be on your confirmation email after you sign up for the test.

What do I bring to the HiSET Test?

- **You must bring \$25 for the entire battery the first time**, or \$5/sub-test the first time, and \$5 for each retest.
- **You must bring a current, government-issued picture ID**. You must be able to prove Montana residency.
- **If you are 17 or 18**, you must bring official documentation showing you are not enrolled in public school.
- **If you are 16**, you must have already secured your official test waiver from the state.
- **If you are 16, 17, or 18, you will need an override to sign up**. You need required letters to get an override.

What time do I have to be at the test center?

You are able to register for the time you want to take each test. The first testing slot starts at 8:00 AM.

In what order are the HiSET Subject Tests given?
